

The INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE STUDENT is a unique project, non-profit and pioneer in the world, dedicated to promote and disseminate the history of student life.

The collection has material from the 16th to the 21st centuries, coming from seventy seven countries of the five continents. The funds, which exceed three thousand original pieces, are owned by Roberto Martinez del Rio and are part of the directory of "Hispana" digitization projects of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports of Spain.

The Museum aims to serve as reference, consultation, dissemination, study and research of the history of education, with special reference to the history of universities, covering the period from the creation of the first studies to today. This museum space will allow visitors to enjoy the rich and extensive legacy that students have left over the centuries.

The INTERNATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE STUDENT FOUNDATION was established in July 2022, with the aim of protecting, promoting and disseminating the historical heritage of the student world, through the creation of the International Museum of the Student, which will house and exhibit the international student life collection owned by Roberto Martínez del Río, as well as other collections that may be incorporated in the future.

Additionally, the purpose of the FOUNDATION is to promote and contribute to education and culture, by carrying out activities aimed at helping students without resources, especially vulnerable or at risk of social exclusion, so that they can carry out their studies regardless of their origin, seeking the generation of employment opportunities and promoting their social and labor insertion.

Crean desde Salamanca una web con 2.500 obras originales sobre la vida estudiantil en 53 países desde el siglo XVI.


Grabados de estudiantes alemanes, británicos y portugueses, entre otros, ilustran la vida universitaria en Monasterio de El Escorial, Juan de la Cuna o Gustavo Díaz. Los estudiantes de la Universidad García Lorca, Cervantes o Tiro de Molina. Una ontología de 22 páginas que incluye 2.500 imágenes procedentes de más de 2.600 piezas originales protegidas por estudiantes, sin algunas de las joyas originales que se conservan en el Museo del Estudiante.

En la actualidad, cada rincón de cada uno de los 53 países que forman parte del proyecto tiene su propia colección objetos vinculados con la historia de la juventud. Algunos han sido llevados hasta el mundo, hasta hoy, más de 2.200 años, otros van desde los grabados a los sombreros, de los carteles y revistas, del cine a las estampas, de los instrumentos musicales a los pliegos de cartas y fotografías, de los banderines a las medallas. Hace 10 años, la Universidad de Salamanca aprobó crear el Museo del Estudiante, siguiendo el ejemplo presentado por el profesor Roberto Martínez del Río. Nueve años después, tras cuatro intentos, la institución académica no daba ningún paso para su crea-
